Itinerary

Day 1: Australia - Vancouver

Fly from Australia to Vancouver. Vancouver Attractions Trolley Hop On / Hop Off Tour (valid 48 hrs)
Accommodation: Blue Horizon Hotel, Vancouver (2 nights)

Day 2: Vancouver

Free day in Vancouver.

Day 3: Vancouver – Jasper (onboard train)

Day at leisure in Vancouver. VIA Rail journey from Vancouver to Jasper.
Accommodation: Upper & Lower Berth onboard VIA Rail (1 night)

Day 4: Arrive Jasper

Travel through dramatic scenery onboard the train. Around lunch time begin the passage into the Canadian Rockies with views of snow-capped peaks, Pyramid Falls and the expansive glaciers of the Albretha Icefields. Pass by Mount Robson, which at 3954 metres is the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Arrive in Jasper at 4.00pm and transfer to the hotel. (B,L)
Accommodation: Lobstick Lodge, Jasper (2 nights)

Day 5: Maligne Canyon Ice Walk (operates mid December to mid April).

Day is at leisure. In the evening experience the wonders of the Maligne Canyon from the ground up! The canyon has withstood 10,000 years of erosion and has created a 165 foot gorge. Certified guides will lead groups of no more than 12 along the frozen canyon floor and its ice-clad limestone walls. Super soles and winter boots will keep guests warm and secure exploring this wonderland of rock and ice.

Day 6: Jasper – Lake Louise & Sleigh Ride

Coach transfer along the Icefield Parkway from Jasper to Lake Louise. This spectacular drive through glacier country will be highlighted by massive snow covered mountains, frozen waterfalls and broad reaching valleys. Evening Sleigh Ride beside the lake (mid December to mid March).
Accommodation: Deer Lodge, Lake Louise (1 night)

Day 7: Lake Louise – Banff

Coach transfer Lake Louise to Banff via the scenic Bow Valley.
Accommodation: Banff Ptarmigan Inn, Banff (2 nights)

Day 8: Banff

Day at leisure in Banff. Try the unique shopping in Banff, skiing or boarding at one of 3 ski resorts in the area (not included) or soak and have a massage at the fabulous, luxurious Solace Spa at the Banff Springs Hotel (not included).

Day 9: Banff – Calgary – Australia

Morning at leisure in Banff. Coach transfer Banff to Calgary Airport. Fly from Calgary to Australia.

Day 10: Inflight.

Day 11: Arrive Australia.
