Day 1. Sat 7 Sept: Home - Melbourne

We arrive into Melbourne after our afternoon flights and transfer to our accommodation for a rest before dinner.

Day 2. Sun 8 Sept: Melbourne - Lakes Entrance

Breakfast & Dinner

This morning after boarding our coach we make our way across towards the beautiful Gippsland Lakes Region. In Morwell we enjoy morning tea from the coach in the grounds of the **Gippsland Immigration Park** which celebrates the contribution of immigrants to the development of Gippsland. Leaving Morwell continue across to **Sale** via Fulham stopping by the **John Brady Wood Sculpture Gallery**. Our next stop is over in Sale where we will have time to purchase lunch before joining our **historic cruise**. Drift back into a different time, when waterways were our highways, and journey from the Port of Sale to the landmark Swing Bridge. The scene is set as we board **The Rubeena**, an electric driven wooden boat first launched at Lakes Entrance in 1912. After our cruise we continue our drive down into the beautiful seaside township of Lakes Entrance where we check into our motel with time to freshen up before dinner in Albert & Co.

Day 3. Mon 9 Sept: Lakes Entrance - Boydtown - Eden

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After checkout we begin our drive across to the magical Sapphire Coast enjoying a couple of interesting stops along the way including the **Stony Creek Trestle Bridge** and the elegant **Seahorse Inn** in Boydtown. This boutique hotel situated on the shores of **Twofold Bay** provides stunning views across the bay to Eden. As we enter the Seahorse Inn we are greeted with an ambience of old world charm, complimented by an aesthetically luxurious appeal. **The Cocktail Lounge** provides the perfect place to enjoy a pre-lunch beverage before taking our place at the table in **Bettena's a la carte restaurant** for our dining experience. We then have time to can take a stroll around the expansive lawns and garden before heading up to Eden for our 3 night stay. After a rest and freshen up we gather for dinner.

Day 4. Tues 10 Sept: Oysters, Whales, Highlights

Captain Sponges Oyster Tours are the perfect way to begin our day! This experience takes us on a journey through Pambula Lakes where we are given an insight into the farming of Sydney Rock Oysters, witness an oyster shucking demo and of course get to sample a few for ourselves. After a break for lunch we arrive at the Eden Visitor Information Centre to meet our local tour guide who'll show us the sights, lookouts and highlights in and around Eden including a stop at the Eden Killer Whale Museum to learn about pod leaders - Stranger, Hooky and Cooper. After leaving the museum we head back to our motel for a bit of leisure time before catching up this evening for dinner.

Day 5. Wed 11 Sept: Whale Watching Cruise - Merimbula

Breakfast & Dinner

Today we head to **Eden's Main Wharf** to board our **Twofold Bay Whale Watching Cruise** which takes in the breathtaking scenery, pristine bays and beaches as we learn the history of this whaling port. At this time of year, majestic Humpback whales frequent the waters just off the coast of Eden, at times entering Twofold Bay on their southern migration. Following our cruise we take a drive up to **Merimbula** and check out the sites with our local guide before taking a look through the **Merimbula Visitors Centre** and enjoying some free time to purchase lunch. This afternoon we travel up to the **stunning beach-side township of Tathra**, home of the **historic Steamer Wharf**.

Day 5. Continued

Across in Bega we call into the **Bega Cheese Heritage Centre** to explore the world of cheese, and learn about the history of dairying in the Bega Valley. From Bega it's back down to Eden for dinner and our last night on the Sapphire Coast

Day 6. Thurs 12 Sept: Cabbage Tree Creek - Lakes Entrance

Today we depart Eden and begin our drive back across to Lakes Entrance enjoying a refreshment stop at the unique Cabbage Tree Creek Cafe and Gift Shop. On arrival back at Lake Entrance we enjoy **wine tastings** before **lunch** at the **Wyanga Park Winery.** We then head into Lakes Entrance to check in to our motel before enjoying some leisure time to take a stroll along the promenade to view the **Avenue of Honour Memorial Tree Statues**, maybe pop into the **Sea Shell Museum** or just enjoy a look around the shops. Early evening we gather back at Albert & Co for our tour farewell dinner.

Day 7. Fri 13 Sept: Bairnsdale - Rosedale - Yarragon - Melbourne

Then travel across through Traralgon and down to the **Loy Yang Power Station Miners Lookout**. Leaving the lookout we continue our drive back home with one last stop in the **village of Yarragon** for free time to roam the specialist shops, cafés and eateries to sample some of Gippsland's finest produce. Our journey concludes as we arrive back in Melbourne and check in for our overnight stay. Dinner tonight is in the hotel restaurant.
