We will then continue cruising and make our way towards Phnom Penh, the capital city of Cambodia.

#### Day 7. Fri 25 Oct: Phnom Penh

Today we explore the Killing Fields and the **Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum**, which recalls one of the darkest moments of the 20th century. Later, we a tour takes us to visit the Royal Palace. We also see the Silver Pagoda located within the Royal Palace complex and admire the **Emerald Buddha** carved from baccarat crystal. After dinner, perhaps step out for an evening walk.

#### Day 8. Sat 26 Oct: Border Crossing - Tan Chau

Spend today on board as our ship cruises to the Vietnamese border. This afternoon, can be spent watching a fruitcarving demonstration by the ship's chef while border formalities are carried out and we cross into Vietnam. Our ship cruises towards the small Vietnamese town of Tan Chau.

After breakfast, we transfer to a small boat and travel along the Mekong's tiny tributaries, observing the stilt house villages. Here, go ashore for a tour of Tan Chau by rickshaw. Known as one of the largest silk-weaving centres of Vietnam, visit the fascinating local artisan workshops to learn more about the history of the craft.

#### Day 10. Mon 28 Oct: Sa Dec - Cai Be

Take a boat ride to the charming colonial town of **Sa Dec** for a tour. Visit the former home of Huynh Thuy Le. Here Le's one-time lover, French writer Marguerite Duras penned her best-selling novel, The Lover, about their affair. After lunch, a local boat takes us to the town of Cai Be. Go ashore to see the French Gothic cathedral and visit a local rice paper manufacturer to learn how rice paper is made. After, we visit a coconut candy factory to see how the local sweet is created. We return to the ship and enjoy a final dinner on board.

#### Day 11. Tue 29 Oct: Disembark Ship - Cu Chi Tunnels - Ho Chi Minh City

This morning we disembark at My Tho Port and travel by coach to the **Cu Chi Tunnels**, a tunnel network built by Vietnamese resistance fighters during the Vietnam War. For dinner this evening, we may like to choose one of the nearby local restaurants.
